Polite Reminders

Before School

Children should stay on the path before the side gate opens in the morning and not climb on any of the railings, fence or sensory garden areas for everyone's safety.

Please can we ask that parents leave the school playgrounds when the whistle is blown at 8.55am. This will allow the children to walk into their classes and cloak-room areas without lots of congestion around the door and path areas. Thank you for your cooperation.

Lateness

The Education Welfare Officer (EWO) has advised us that the Council are now prioritising their monitoring of pupil lateness as much as holidays taken in term time. If children do arrive late (after 9am), this is recorded in the registers and a home visit might be arranged by the EWO if a pattern of lateness is seen. Please therefore ensure your child arrives by 8.55am each day.

Health Care Plans

If your child has asthma, or an ongoing medical condition which requires an inhaler or epipen, please ensure the school receives an up to date copy of their health care plan. Inhalers should also include a spacer. It is advised that two epipens if required are in date and left with the school.
