## After School Clubs

A letter was sent home before the half-term holiday outlining the after school activities being offered during the next half-term. The clubs will begin next week and will run until 4.15pm as before.

Despite consultation with pupils, several clubs still need increased numbers to meet the minimum uptake in order for the clubs to run:

**Tuesday**-KS1 Games and craft club  
(at least 4 more children are needed)

**Wednesday**-KS2 Hockey  
(at least 7 more children are needed)

**Thursday**-KS2 Street Dance  
(at least 4 more children are needed). Please confirm any further interest along with the appropriate payment by 9am on Tuesday. If the minimum numbers are not reached, sadly these clubs will have to be cancelled due to the lack of support.

## Winter Uniform

Due to the time of year, children need to bring their school jumpers and a coat with them to school. The expectation is that long trousers rather than summer shorts should also be worn for boys. Winter PE kits which include plain dark jogging bottoms and trainers are also required for any outdoor PE and sport.

Just to confirm that all school uniform is now available to purchases from Shop Direct both in store and online. The only items the school now keeps stock of are PE bags and book bags.
