School Lunch Payments

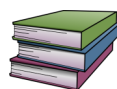

Shire Services encourage parents to pay for school lunches in advance for either the week, half term, or on the day to avoid any outstanding arrears which links to their payment policy.

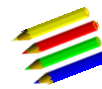
Community Links
