

## Overview of Standards 2015

Please see a summary of the standards at the end of key stage 2 for Year 6 pupils in the 2015 SATs.

(10 pupils in the cohort, 1 child = 10%)

| Science (teacher assessment)                       | 100%  | 60%                                       |

The average point score for the school was 30.6, above the national average of 28.8 in 2015.

Our overall progress data for 2015 puts St Lucia's School in the top 18% of all schools nationally (top 28% for maths, top 15% for reading and top 16% for writing).
