

## CRITICAL WORKERS' REGISTRATION FORM FOR CHILDCARE

The children of critical workers are able to come into school whilst parents are at work, together with vulnerable children and those on an Educational Health Care Plan. Critical Workers are those whose work is critical to the COVID-19 and EU transition response, those in health and social care, education and childcare, key public services, some local and national government employees, food and necessary goods industry, public safety and national security, transport and border control, some utilities, communication and financial services. A full list of critical workers may be found on the gov.uk website. If you unsure, you may ask your employer to confirm whether you are a critical worker.
