

A designated home learning class email will be used to send and receive remote learning if this becomes necessary for a partial/full school closure. A weekly timetable will provide a clear structure of learning activities for pupils throughout the week.

Two pieces of learning will be received and feedback provided to individual pupils by the child's class teacher(s). Marking may include questions/feedback to support progression of skills.

Online videos may be signposted to provide additional information to support the learning. For example White Rose maths videos and follow up activities. Workbooks/worksheets will be provided and set pages/tasks may be given for completion.

A range of different curriculum subjects will be covered within a week. IT programs with individual pupil log ins will be used again. Interaction will be monitored by the class teachers (e.g. Numbots, TT Rock Stars, SPAG) to support spelling, punctuation and grammar and Dyslexia Gold for some pupils)

## Expectations

Children will be strongly encouraged at home to complete their daily remote learning to they don't fall behind.

Parents will make arrangements for an appropriate space for children to complete their remote learning at home.

Parents will support and encourage their child to complete the learning requested by the class teacher and return this electronically for marking using the designated class learning emails.
