## Revised Christmas Events due to present circumstances with Covid

#### **Carol Service**

Following the last parents' update, unfortunately current Covid circumstances, along with an increase in the new Omicron variant and general restrictions have changed. However, we want to do our best to provide Christmas experiences for the children. With careful planning, we are still hoping to go ahead with the Carol service (although this may be subject to change if Covid cases rise), however we will sadly not be able to involve parents and members of our local community as previously hoped. The Church council recently met to revise their forthcoming arrangements and have advised the school they cannot safely accommodate a large number of people in church.

The Living Nativity has been cancelled, but a short Carol service with the need for face coverings to be worn will take place instead this Sunday, 12<sup>th</sup> December at 3pm. It is hoped that the Crib service will go ahead, although a review will be held closer to the time.

Please be reassured that the children will still have the opportunity to sing Christmas Carols together as a school and celebrate the joyous festival of Jesus' birth. We really want to make this a special time for all the children at St Lucia's, whilst also doing the right and responsible thing by protecting them, their parents and the school community this close to Christmas. Please be aware, that other local authorities have now cancelled their Christmas events, so we

are hoping our revised Carol service will go ahead as detailed above. We were pleased to also have the opportunity as a school of singing recently at the Rodington Tree of Light event last week.

## **School Christmas Fayre**

The arrangements for the Christmas Fayre have had to be amended due to the current Covid situation. Opportunity to purchase items made at the Elf Night will be given to the children in their classes on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> December. Children should bring no more than £1. Raffle tickets will also be on sale from the St. Lucia's Friends shortly.
