#### Class 4 Teacher on Fridays

We warmly welcome Mrs S Bishton to St Lucia's School. Mrs Bishton will teach the Year 5/6 class each Friday with a focus on Science and Modern Foreign Languages (French).

#### Shrewsbury Half-Marathon

There is opportunity for your child to take part in a half-marathon on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> April from 9am (Please note this is during the beginning of the Easter holidays). The event will be held at the West Mid Showground in Shrewsbury. **Please inform the school by 9am Friday 11<sup>th</sup> February using the return slip at the end of this letter and a £12 entry fee to secure a place** (this will include a yellow marathon t-shirt and medal on completion). The long distance running event is open to children from 4-11 years old. School will support practises during lunchtimes, although some commitment will also be involved outside of school to contribute to the 13.1 mile total. The last 1.1 mile will be run at the event. For every school which takes place, a tree will be planted as part of the canopy project to celebrate the Queen's Jubilee.

#### School Council

Although all positive Covid cases were eradicated recently, we have been informed of 3 children testing positive in the upper key stage 2 yesterday. We ask for your continued support to encourage regular LFT tests if your child is feeling unwell, or to have a PRC test if any symptoms are showing which can be more reliable. It appears that an upset stomach can be one of these symptoms. As a school, we are following the regional guidance and continuing with caution to keep all protective measures in place.
