Key Stage 2 SATs - Monday 9<sup>th</sup> May until Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> May Key Stage 1 SATs - Monday 16<sup>th</sup> May until Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> May Year 1 Phonics screening check –Week commencing Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> June Year 4 Multiplication Check- Week commencing Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> June onwards
