### DROP OFF AND PICK UP

To improve ease of communication with class teachers, we are pleased to welcome our families to enter and exit through the school playground, dropping off and collecting children at their external classroom door. Parents and Carers will be greeted by Miss Coleman at the front of the building and invited to walk past the hall and through the gate onto the playground, accompanying children around to their class teacher. Class teachers will be waiting to greet pupils with parents and carers and will be available for brief daily communication (such as for parents/carers to pass on that a child has enjoyed reading their book at home, to ask a quick question or pass on a message). Timings as follows:

8.45am - Parents invited onto site and doors opened for registration at 8.50am

3.15pm- Bell to ring for end of school day, gates to open and parents and carers invited to collect
