








DONATIONS



Bookings for Sunrise Club for after half term should be made on the School Money system please.

Sunrise Club will remain at £5.50 per session, running from 7.45am each day. Breakfast will now be included within the price - providing children with JNRISE CLUB cereal and/or toast with fruit juice. All pupils requiring breakfast are asked to attend by 8.20am please.

SUNSET CLUB

Sunset Club will continue to be available each evening, bookings should be made on School Money please.

We are trialling a slightly different set up of these after school sessions for the second half of the Summer Term, giving all children the opportunity to enjoy a theme club for the first hour and then wrap around care from 4.15pm onwards. Due to parental requests and feedback we will trial offering an extended session from Monday-Thursday.

Sunset Club will now be booked in three slots with staggered pricing:

- 3.15-4.15 Theme Club (pick up at 4.15) £3.50
- 4.15-5.15 Wraparound (to include a drink and biscuit, anytime pick up within slot) +£3.50
- 5.15-5.45 Extended wraparound +£2

Tuesday - <u>YOGA CLUB</u> join Emm and Sahara from Bridgnorth Yoga Studio 'join us for interactive yoga games, activities and challenges...with drums, sound bowls, balls and other props we can combine wellbeing, learning and movement all in one class!'

Wednesday - <u>ART AND CRAFT CLUB</u> enjoy the opportunity to get creative with Mrs Nelson!



BOOKINGS: These clubs are available for all children (not just those who require wrap around care). We have made provision to increase numbers, however places will be limited due to staffing. We would continue to ask that bookings are made in advance please. For the first week the booking system will remain open so we can support you to use it. Moving forwards the booking system will close at midnight on the Thursday of the week before so that arrangements can be made. Any parents/carers who use an alternative method of payment (e.g. Childcare vouchers, Edenred, Computer Share Vouchers etc) are asked to use the 'reserve' session on School Money and will be provided with a form to note the payment reference please. All other bookings will need to be made by 'online booking' the session.

We will of course be on hand to help as we all learn to use the system, please just let us know if you have any queries and we will be happy to help resolve them. Thank you in anticipation of your patience and support as we transfer bookings across!
