Strategic Objectives, September 2023

1. Quality of Education

- a) Ensure our curriculum is coherently planned and sequenced towards cumulatively sufficient knowledge and skills for future learning, through effective sequencing and progression in all subjects. From this, ensure the successful implementation of high quality teaching, so pupils can remember and apply their learning, develop the cultural capital they need for the future and are enthused, inspired and supported to make progress.
- b) Ensure that the school's successful record in statutory tests is maintained and that area's identified from internal data analysis have a clear refined focus to support progress.

2. Behaviour and Attitudes

- a) Enrich our practices and create an environment which empowers and supports us to live our Christian vision; where pupil behaviour and conduct is consistently of a high standard with pupils maintaining high levels of engagement, commitment to learning, developing resilience and pride in all aspects of school life.
- b) To ensure attendance remains at national or above for all groups and persistent absenteeism is below national.
